The City of Monroe creates a locate ticket through the Georgia Utilities Protection Center to locate any public utilities that may be in the area when we are preparing to install an underground utility service line to a house.

The City of Monroe will **NOT** be responsible for any damage other than to a public utility that occurs while installing the underground utility service line. This includes, *but is not limited to*, damage to the following:

- Sod
- Septic tanks
- Driveways
- Landscape materials (trees, flowers, shrubs, etc.)
- Sprinkler systems
- Sidewalks
- Mailboxes

It is up to the developer/builder/homeowner (whichever applies) to make sure that nothing impedes the underground utility service line being installed. Should damage other than to a public utility occur during installation of an underground utility service line, it will be the responsibility of the developer/builder/homeowner to repair.

Rock Clause: Should the City of Monroe or its contractor(s) encounter rock during the installation of the utility service line, the developer/builder/homeowner (whichever applies) will be billed for the excavation and removal of rock from the area.
