The City of Monroe is accepting applications for the position of Police Officer. The purpose of this classification is to provide protection of life and property; enforcement of federal, state, and local laws; response to emergency situations; investigation of criminal activity; provision of crime prevention information and proactive patrol; and assignment to specialized units within the department including Support Services, Housing Authority, School Resource Officer, Special Operations Unit, or others.

Work is performed according to established policies and procedures; therefore, a Police Officer must be able to exercise sound judgment, especially in emergency situations. Work requires tact, conscientiousness, and the effective and efficient performance of duties with minimal supervision.

Work involves a substantial element of personal risk, The Police Officer may be required to use force to effect an arrest, protect themselves, or protect others. The use of force may include the use of physical force up to and including deadly force.

A Police Officer may be subjected to verbal and physical abuse and may be required to investigate or view psychologically disturbing material, including child pornography, child-involved fatalities, autopsies, and other death-related scenes.

Salary is commensurate with qualifications. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions of the job.

Qualifications & Experience:

- Have a high school diploma or GED – Associates degree or equivalent preferred
 - Ability to successfully complete Georgia Peace Officers Standards and Training mandated training; ability to obtain and maintain P.O.S.T. Certification; ability to meet and maintain compliance with present and future Georgia P.O.S.T. and City of Monroe standards for employment as a Police Officer. Possession of or ability to readily obtain a valid driver's license issued by the State of Georgia for the type of vehicle or equipment operated.
 - No convictions of a felony or sufficient misdemeanors to establish a pattern of disregard for the law; no convictions for felony or misdemeanor while employed; honorable discharge from the US Military; successful completion of applicant selection process
 - Ability to read, understand, and abide by City of Monroe and City of Monroe Police Department's Personnel Policy and Standard Operating Procedures
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Selection Process:

Applicants who meet the minimum qualifications may be invited to participate in the selection process, which may include application review, interviews, reference checks, and other job-related assessments. Employment is contingent upon the successful completion of all applicable pre-employment requirements, which may include, but are not limited to, a criminal background check, drug screening, motor vehicle record review, physical examination or physical abilities testing (when required), and any additional job-related screenings deemed necessary.
